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AIMS & OBJECTIVE

The terrain of Dadra and Nagar Haveli is undulating to hilly receiving average rainfall 2200mm to 2500mm and hence vulnerable to soil erosion. The main concern of Soil Conservation Department is therefore to treat the land with integrated measures like Bench Terracing Work, Contour Bunding Work, Gully Control Work and Afforestation Work to prevent soil erosion, maintain soil fertility, conserve soil moisture, to maintain the longevity of Damanganga reservoir, control floods and for better productivity, socio economic development of rural populace and environmental protection and preservation. Over and above this programme is being labour oriented, provides employment to the rural people to their door steps during the lean period of Agriculture season and avoid migration of labourers.

Agriculture Supervisor (SC) has to check survey and make alignment in Rough Contour Plan as per field condition and submit it for approval to SDSCO again.</p> <p>After obtaining approval, Agriculture Supervisor has to prepare Fair Plan Estimate and submit it to SDSCO for seeking Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction from the Administration end.</p> <p>After receiving Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction, Agriculture Assistant starts execution in the field by engaging labourers.</p>	
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
