**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers vested in him, the Administrator of Dadra and Nagar Haveli is pleased to notify the UT Plan Scheme namely Incentive to, Girl students for pursuing Professional Courses at Graduate and Post Graduate Level as follows:

- 1) **Objective :-** To Provide financial benefit to Girl students for pursuing Graduate and Post Graduate level Professional courses.
- 2) **Salient Feature**
  - (i) There are approximately 1500 students appearing for the HSC examination every year in the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and there is only one Government College in Dadra and Nagar Haveli where the students of the UTs can pursue graduate studies. Further there is only one Private Professional Education Institution where the students can pursue studies for Arts, Science, Commerce, MBA, B. Pharma, B. Ed and D.Ed. Number of seats allotted in different educational Institutions on all India basis by the Government of India for Engineering and Medical Courses is also very small in number.
  - (ii) Thus the students have limited opportunity to pursue higher studies, more so because they have to move outside the UT and most often have to pay high fees in other private institutions. The situation is even more acute in the case of girl students because parents are reluctant to spend large amount of money on girls education due to economic constraints. In these circumstances the GER for higher studies in the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli is low as per 2001 census, which is very low compared to the national average of 12.4%.

- (iii) Considering these facts, the UT Administration of Dadra and Nagar Haveli has decided to promote women's education by providing monetary assistance to girl students for pursuing graduate and post graduate courses in various professional and technical institutions in the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and also outside the UT but within India only.
- (iv) The scheme of Incentive to girl students for pursuing professional courses at graduate and post graduate level is not applicable to those girl students for pursuing graduate/ post graduate professional courses in the institutes out of India.

### 3) Pattern of assistance

50% of fees (non-refundable) reimbursement under UT plan scheme for girl students who are pursuing professional courses in recognized university/institution and un-aided colleges whose fees has been approved by State / UT Fee fixation committee.

### 4) Eligibility Criteria

- (i) Passed with 50% aggregate marks or (50 Marks in PCM / PCB subjects including practical) in the HSSC Examination with all subjects taken together in the same attempt (single sitting) for graduate level courses and Passed with 50% marks in Graduation for Post Graduation level courses shall be considered.
- (ii) (a) At least one of the Parents of the applicant should be permanent resident of Dadra and Nagar Haveli with at least 12 years residency and students should have studied continuously for at least 5 years in any of the Higher Secondary Schools of this U.T. including the year of qualifying examination (i.e. HSC Examination).
- (b) In case the parents of the applicant are the employees of the Administration of Dadra and Nagar Haveli, they should have completed 5-years service & 5-years residence in this U.T. of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and applicant should have studied 5-years in any of the Higher Secondary Schools of this U.T. including year of qualifying examination (i.e. HSSC Examination).
- (c) Scholarship will be continued for the girl student who has passed the Annual / Semester examinations with all subjects taken together in the same attempt (single sitting) during Graduate and Post Graduate level studies and the benefit will be withdrawn for those girl students who have failed in the annual / semester examination in a particular semester / year.

### 5) Scholarship

- (ci) Reimbursement of 50% fees (non-refundable) annual/semester as per actual calculated on the basis on production of the fees receipt in original from College/University authority from time to time.
- (cii) U.T. Administration of Dadra and Nagar Haveli will be provided 100% of Recurring expenditure from UT Plan Budget and this scheme shall come into force with effect from the year 2011- 2012.
